### A Tingira and WBAQ Coalition Fleet Attends Matthew Flinders' Day on Coochiemudlo Island



A combined fleet of 24 boats from the Tingira Boat Club and the Wooden Boat Association of Queensland attended the annual Matthew Flinders' Landing Commemoration held on Coochiemudlo Island on Sunday 15th July.

The mixed fleet included 8 traditional wooden sailing dinghies; 2 six person outrigger canoes; 4 trailer sailers; 3 Vagabond sailing dinghies; 2 safety RIBS; 2 motor runabouts; 1 yacht, 1 trimaran and 1 double kayak canoe.

The fleet launched early on Sunday morning from the Tingira Boat Club in what could easily be described as picture perfect weather. **A bit too perfect in fact** - with there being very little breeze to fill the sails. The six person outrigger canoes and double kayak found the conditions ideal but the sail boats had to find alternate means of propulsion until finally a light northerly breeze became available in later that morning.



With so little breeze the sailing boats needed to find alternate means of propulsion. Seen here is **Dennis Scott** from the Wooden Boat Association Qld paddling his beautiful Eureka Canoe that has been modified with the addition of outriggers and a sail. Dennis had camped overnight at Tingira and had attended the Pirate Ball the night before.
