Calvert Memorial Sailing Series - Event 1

Ten boats nominated for the 1st event of the Calvert Memorial Sailing Series on Sunday. It was a quite a sight to see those sails milling around the start line.

Ivan Scott, Dudley Kavanagh, Don Noble and Neville Prosser did a great job aboard the Tingira Pontoon of conducting the start sequence which had the participating yachts on their way just after 11:00am.



With a south westerly wind blowing the boats sailed down wind from the start line to the first mark. It wasn't long until there were colourful spinnakers set to make the most of the fading breeze. 'Celeste' a pretty Herreshoff Rozinante skippered by Bill Morley (Pelican Slipways) really enjoyed the light conditions and seemed to glide effortlessly through the water as she made her way to the first mark.

Unfortunately the SW breeze faded away (as per the WillyWeather wind prediction) and the fleet was lucky to reach the first mark (Banana Bank North Beacon) before it disappeared all together. The sailing committee decided to shorten the course as there seemed to be little chance of the breeze returning any time soon. Fortunately the shepherd boat, 'Impetuous' (Max and Cathy Keily), was stationed at the beacon and was able to record the time each boat rounded the mark. This enabled the sailing committee to work out both the line and handicap places for the first event. The fleet then mostly motor sailed back to Macleay Island. It was not quite the event we were hoping for - but that's sailing!

Actually everyone seemed quite happy to be just out on the bay messing about in a boat on that beautiful sunny Autumn Sunday.
