Mirror Dinghy Restoration - Day 4

Our group met again last Wednesday 19 May to continue work on restoring the Mirror Dinghy that has been donated to the Boat Club. Start time was at noon but work on the project was postponed for a short time while some of us enjoyed eating our pies purchased from the new bakery at 5 Star. It just felt like 'pie eating' day.

The first half of our work session was spent removing the old varnish coating from inside the hull and gunwales using sanding machines where possible and then by sanding by hand in the more difficult to get to areas. The hull was then flipped over so that we could trim and lightly sand the fibreglass sheath that had been applied the previous week.

An additional coating of epoxy resin was then applied to the surface of the hull using a roller and brush. The outside of the hull is now started to look much better and once given time to dry ready for some high build bog and primer.

Queensland Check in App

The Queensland Government has made it mandatory that all pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes in Queensland change to the Queensland Check-In App to allow attendees to register their presence electronically.

The Tingira Boat Club will switch to this form of QR recording as from Friday April 16, 2021.

All you need to do is:

- ✓ Download Queensland Check-In app from Google Play or Apple App stores
- ✓ enter your details once when you first open the app
- ✓ open the app when you next visit us
- ✓ select 'Check-in Now' and scan or enter our code

You only have to ever enter your details once.

You can use it at any venue using the Queensland Check-In App.

If you do not have a suitable smart phone, you can still enter your details on the sheets available which will be added electronically by staff later.

Using this digital check in means your details will be stored securely by the Queensland Government for 56 days to assist with COVID-19 contact tracing (if needed).

The Check-In Qld app is safe, secure and private. By using it, you are helping Queensland's pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes to stay open, and you can visit us with confidence, knowing you can be contacted quickly and easily if there is any risk of exposure to the virus.
