#### Mirror Dinghy Restoration Project - Day 6 (02/06/21)



Our work continued on restoring the Mirror dinghy last Wednesday. We began with the very dusty work of taking away the old varnish from inside the hull with the help of a sanding machine. Some of the more tricky places required the sanding to be done by hand using sandpaper and scrapers. Then came the job of removing some tough, grungy enamel paint from the cockpit floor. This was done mainly by hand using scrapers and a heat gun.

Once we had had quite enough of sanding and scraping for the day, we tipped the hull over and enjoyed the more pleasant task of applying high build two pack undercoat to the hull with everyone taking a turn to roll out the paint.

Several coats were applied as the paint became touch dry in a short time. With two (and in most places three) coats applied it was time to clean up and put the Mirror away in the shed for the paint to dry.

Time then to enjoy a cuppa (and some mud cake) and discuss next week's adventures of our restoration work.

Our group will meet again this **Wednesday 09 June at 10:00am** and we are planning to apply some varnish to the inside of the hull and the wooden spars. **Those interested in taking a look or giving a hand are most welcome**.

#### **Queensland Check in App**

The Queensland Government has made it mandatory that all pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes in Queensland change to the Queensland Check-In App to allow attendees to register their presence electronically.

The Tingira Boat Club will switch to this form of QR recording as from Friday April 16, 2021.

All you need to do is:

- ✓ Download Queensland Check-In app from Google Play or Apple App stores
- ✓ enter your details once when you first open the app
- ✓ open the app when you next visit us
- ✓ select 'Check-in Now' and scan or enter our code

You only have to ever enter your details once.

You can use it at any venue using the Queensland Check-In App.

If you do not have a suitable smart phone, you can still enter your details on the sheets available which will be added electronically by staff later.

Using this digital check in means your details will be stored securely by the Queensland Government for 56 days to assist with COVID-19 contact tracing (if needed).

The Check-In Qld app is safe, secure and private. By using it, you are helping Queensland's pubs, clubs, restaurants and cafes to stay open, and you can visit us with confidence, knowing you can be contacted quickly and easily if there is any risk of exposure to the virus.
