

Right on cue, a half hour before the scheduled start time, the wind stirred and showed that it was going to live up to the forecast, increasing gradually from a gentle 8 knots to 12 knots and then to a very fresh 20 knots immediately after the start.

Luckily, rather than sailing the regular Calvert course (a triangle set north of Macleay Island), the sailing sub-committee decided to trial an alternate inshore course devised for stronger winds. With winds gusting to 20 knots and over, those that were sailing in the smaller 18ft Jubilees were rather grateful that they were not out in the more open bay



Tucanu owned and skippered by Trevor Rogers and crewed by Don Newman led the fleet from start to finish achieving fastest time and fastest multihull.




Skirmish owned and sailed by Tony and Lyn Harland gained fastest time for the monohulls and second overall.
