Queensland Jubilee Championships - A Great Success

Nine Jubilee One-Design Yachts took part in the 2nd Queensland Championships hosted by the Tingira Boat Club last weekend. The regatta consisting of 6 races was held over Saturday and Sunday with three races each day.

What a colourful sight they made with their spinnakers up and sailing a course set close and parallel to the western coast of Macleay Island. Being one design yachts meant that there was some very close (sometimes fierce) but good spirited racing.

The wind behaved itself on both days during race time and although light to begin with on Saturday, the competing yachts had ample breeze to make their way around the course for the duration of the series. The northerly breeze allowed a windward work and then a downwind spinnaker run.

The series was convincingly won by **Stella** (J123) skippered by Euan Macdonald and crewed by Tony Harland (part owner).

Stella sailed very consistently throughout the event achieving three 1st places on Saturday and then one 1st place and two 2nd places on Sunday. Their accumulative score (using a low score system) was 8 points.

In second place (with 15 points) was *Isabel* (J124) skippered by Bruce Legg (owner) and crewed by Ian Waller-Wilkinson and Peter Fox. Third overall with was *Andiamo* (with 19 points) skippered by Alison Early and crewed by Dave Gemmell (owner) and Barry Rawlinson all from Lamb Island.

Alison also earned herself the **Female Skipper Award** for her efforts on the tiller.

Beverly skippered by Ian Dickson and crewed by Peter Hope and Danny Wachtel won **The Pump Trophy** which is dedicated to the wooden boat with the fastest times.

The **Youngest Skipper Award** went to Ethan Harcourt who sailed aboard **Sarina Lea** with his father Andrew Harcourt and grandfather Rob Harcourt (owner). 3 generations of a family sailing together!!

The wind however did not behave itself on Saturday night.

A strong northerly breeze blew up sending both *Sarina Lea* and *Nereid* to the shore with dragging anchors. Luckily both ended up washed up on the sand at Sandpiper Beach. A rescue mission was organised early

Sunday morning and a group of 20 sailors and Tingira Club members managed to drag *Sarina Lea* closer to the incoming tide. *Sarina Lea* was successfully refloated in time for the first race, and remarkably went on to achieve first place in the first race.

Unfortunately *Nereid* was not refloated in time and Mike King withdrew from the Sunday racing and took *Nereid* (undamaged) back to her mooring at Dalpura
