## **A Message From Our Commodore**


### **Ahoy to all Tingira Members!**

## Renewal of Lease to Tingira Boat Club Update

As Commodore Moss explained in his message above, the current Lease held by the Tingira Club over 91 Coast Road is due to expire on 28 February 2022. The Club has been invited to renew our lease for a standard lease term of up to 10 years.

We have forwarded the documents required to support our application to Council including audited financial records for the past three years.

As part of the process a building compliance inspection was carried out by a council inspector last Friday to ensure legislative requirements are being met and check the general condition of the buildings and ongoing regular maintenance. We have received very positive feedback from the inspection and a small list of recommendations including the provision of new compliant signage for our toilet doors.

In closing the inspector noted, 'I would like to compliment the club on the level of regular maintenance and care that obviously is taken in looking after the facility which is reflected in its excellent condition'.

## **Tingira To the Rescue**

Last Friday five adventurous Island lads decided to take a swim from Sandpiper Beach Park out to our Club pontoon, a distance of about 300m or so.

During the swim out to the pontoon, there was a disconcerting, real or imagined, sighting of a bull shark cruising through the water.

Standing safely on the Pontoon, the lads saw that the return swim to the shore was rather a long way, especially with a real or imagined bull shark lurking somewhere in between.

Three of the five decided to brave the water and swim back to shore, but two remained on the pontoon determined they were not going to pit themselves against a marauding bull shark.

Meanwhile on our Club deck ,some of our committee members were discussing the outcomes of our just completed Council building inspection. The discussion however was interrupted by three of the returning lads asking to borrow kayaks from the Club so that they could go out and rescue their two stranded friends on the pontoon - who were refusing to risk swimming back.

Yes! Looking out at the Pontoon, there they were, waving frantically for assistance. **But wait!** Anchored close by to the Pontoon was newly arrived trawler and a houseboat. This added credence surely to the real or imagined sighting of a bull shark. Sharks and trawlers seem to have a cosy relationship.

Time for decisive action perhaps! Now enters Kerry Otter with her motherly instincts all ablaze, "Moss! Max! Pete! Bob! you must go out and get them, they reckon they've seen sharks!". Yes action indeed seemed warranted!

So *Sandpiper*, our rescue RIB, was quickly launched and off went Commodore Moss and Vice Commodore Max to the rescue. They picked up the two strandees from the Pontoon and landed them safely back at Tingira. A very big thank you from all the lads, photos were taken, and I promised sincerely I would not mention to anyone details of their misadventure.

On a positive note it was great to put to use our newly installed electric winch to retrieve **Sandpiper** from the water - it worked well, no effort at all.
