OC6 Paddling Get-Together - Sunday 01 May

We have invited outrigger paddlers from Coochiemudlo Island, Bayside Cleveland and the Talobilla Waka Ama Club (Scarborough) to join our Tingira paddlers for a casual and fun day of paddling. The plans for the paddling get-together to be held on Sunday 01 May have been revised and refined and are now as follows.

The planned event still includes a novel 5km paddle (dubbed the Crossover Flag Snatch) with paddlers based on Coochiemudlo Island crossing over in their OC6s to the Tingira Club and snatching a flag from the Tingira beach and then paddling back halfway to finish at the Club pontoon. Meanwhile the Tingira based teams will cross over to Coochie, snatch a flag from their beach and finish half way back at the Pontoon. The first mixed team (male/female with a minimum of 3 female crew members) to make it to the Pontoon with a snatched flag will be deemed the winner. All boats will commence the crossover with a simultaneous start. There is a course map for reference at the end of this article.

Following the Crossover Flag Snatch there will be a morning recess between 10:30am - 11:00am at the Tingira Club to allow the paddlers to refuel and hydrate.

The next events will be 400m sprints set on a straight course running parallel with Sandpiper Beach and take place straight out from the Clubhouse. These will commence at about 11:15am and should be quite entertaining to watch from the shore.

The paddlers will then be invited for lunch and well earned refreshments at our normal **Sunday On the Deck** from 12:00pm. During lunch there will be a presentation of prizes and awards by our Commodore Moss Lane and Sailing Master Ian Waller-Wilkinson.

A summary of the arrangements for the day are as follows:

The Island (Macleay & Coochiemudlo) Crossover Flag Snatch (5 km approx)

8:00am: Crews meet to assist with the setting up and preparing their OC6s

9:00am: Muster of OC6 teams at the designated start points either on

Macleay or Coochiemudlo Islands.

9:30am (sharp): Simultaneous start for all teams from their designated start position on Coochiemudlo or Macleay Island. Teams cross over to the opposite island to snatch a flag and then finish at the Tingira Pontoon positioned halfway between Coochiemudlo and Macleay Island (see map at the end of this article).

10:30am – 11:00am: Morning Tea Break at Tingira Boat Club

Banana bread, tea, coffee and cool drinks will be available for purchase at the Tingira Clubhouse.

11:15am: OC6 Sprints (400m)

Crews attend a briefing for the OC6 Sprints at the Tingira Clubhouse. Crews will then take part in a 400m sprint on a straight course set parallel to the Sandpiper beach shoreline. The finish line will be between a buoy and the Club pontoon position straight out in front of the Clubhouse.

12:00 – 1:00pm: Lunch and presentation of a perpetual trophy and other prizes.

Burgers and salads will be available from the Club kitchen. The Club bar will be open from 12:00pm.


