Then it was time to rig and launch the boats. Warren Goulding and John Dennys crewed the safety RIB *Sandpiper* to keep an eye on the safety of our sailors and transport the race officials out to the pontoon. Marion Mori, Don Noble and Jen Rush did an awesome job of starting and finishing the races with perfect timing.
